- Skiing: Canadian Ski Instructors' Alliance Level 1 (minimum) certificate, or in the process of obtaining it.
- Snowboarding: Canadian Snowboard Instructors Alliance Level 1 (minimum) certificate, or in the process of obtaining it.

- Follow all health and safety directives of the company

Additional (for NEW Instructors)

However, it's *not a prerequisite* to taking the certification course, if you choose to go directly to the course, contact us once you have completed it.
- Suggestion: Register for the pre-course on the 26 or 27 of Nov. This can be done in the proroom at Camp Fortune.
- Attending training and / or passing your level 1 does not guarantee steady posting with one of the programs.
